Each Douglas fir timber has a custom rough sawn texture achieved through the careful application of a chain saw and wire brushing. Many of the timbers interface with the windows to form a more direct relationship between the structure and the outdoors.

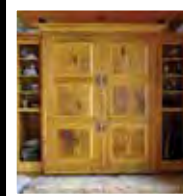
