Situated adjacent to the main house, this Douglas fir timber frame gathering barn provides open space with plenty of opportunities for folks to mingle and relax. We enclosed the frame with structural insulated panels (SIPs) and framed the exterior wall beyond the panels allowing large screen doors to slide in or out as the barn doors are opened. Opening the doors provides fresh air and a natural flow of guests through the main corridor of the barn.

We worked closely with Bully Hill Vineyards on this multi-phase project to create open-air spaces that would allow patrons to enjoy stunning views of Keuka Lake along with great wine and food. The dining room and pavilion are connected by floor-to-ceiling windows and doors allowing both natural light and lake views to reach all areas. Cool and clean reclaimed ash flooring was paired with warm toned Douglas fir parallel chord trusses for the interior dining space.

The leaders of this historic town, birthplace of the women's rights movement, wanted to add a shelter to one of their parks. It needed to be done in a way that complemented their storied past. The resulting Douglas fir timber frame pavilion takes its cue from the arch-topped church windows of its Anglo-Gothic style neighbor, Trinity Church. When the snow melts, its traditional copper roof will be exposed.

Behind the Frame

Sophisticated Technology: We have long believed in balancing efficient, modern equipment with high levels of craft. Our two bi-coastal CNC joinery lines allow more timber framing in your budget, with no loss of quality or flexibility, also giving us the option to produce large, complex jobs.



Hand-Crafted Finishing: We could throw out adjectives like meticulous and painstaking, but they wouldn't convey the artistry and craftsmanship found in timber framing. Our timber framers are master craftsmen, with a deep desire to create something enduring, belonging to a pool of artisans with a rare skill and innate understanding of heavy timber. Their knowledge and attention to detail is applied to each timber in your frame.



Personalized Carving: It has been our long standing tradition that a timber in the frame is carved with either the year it was raised, a phrase, or a name. The carving is often crafted on the bottom chord of one of the prominent trusses in the frame. A place where you, your family, and friends can appreciate it daily.



Raising The Frame: With New Energy Works, the craftsmen that cut your frame also raise it, bringing their knowledge of the project and timber framing experience to the site. That same knowledge allows us to condense the raising process, shortening on-site erection time. At the end we'll place a pine bough on the highest peak to honor the forest, the structure, the craftsmen, and the people that will soon inhabit the frame.



Enclosing the Frame: Timber framing allows for a highly efficient home, particularly when enclosed with a pre-cut panel system such as Structural Insulated Panels (SIPs) or our own Matrix wall assembly. Pre-fabricated panel systems provide higher R values and nearly eliminate thermal bridging for optimal temperature regulation, and streamlines time spent on the site.



General Contracting: For years, New Energy Works has been the builder on a select number of homes each year. The process helps us more fully understand what it takes to complete a project, while allowing us to create some amazing and award-winning houses. Whether or not we act as your builder or only your timber wright, this ongoing experience makes us a good partner.



Fine Woodworking: We believe that timber framing is sculpture you live in and that elements like stairs, doors, and cabinetry should complement your frame. This is why our own fine woodworking group, *NEWwoodworks*, came to be. Our craftsmen understand how to help tell the story of your frame with a balance of texture, design, and craft.

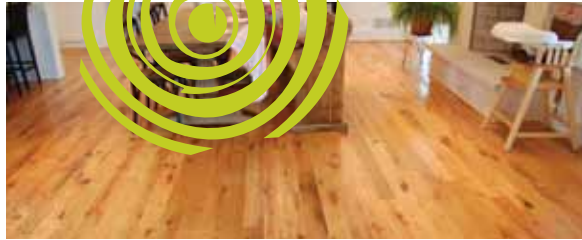
